DESCRIPTION

Mayotte, the French department that lies between Madagascar and Mozambique, is facing an important increase in the youth unemployment. One of the reasons for that is the ignorance of the regional employment market including one in particular: The Fashion Industry.

Therefore, the Au Fil des Îles - École Régionale des Métiers de la Mode - project set out to answer the need of textile-fashion technicians in the regional industry and to create job opportunities for those unemployed youth.

The aim was to make Mayotte a shared professional training space for the wider East Africa region's textiles and fashion industries – with neighbouring Madagascar and the Union of the Comoros also a part of the project. Local young people, small and medium-sized businesses, and the entrepreneurial sector were supported through training, employment and social integration with industry partners in East Africa.
